Position Summary:

We are seeking compassionate, responsible, and resilient individuals to join our team as Casual Residential Care Providers in a specialized residential program supporting two homes, each with two high-risk teenage girls, currently in the care of CFS.

The youth in this home have experienced sexual exploitation, trauma, addictions and complex emotional and behavioral needs. Staff play a critical role in providing consistent supervision, emotional support, safety planning, and trauma-informed care within a caring, supportive, non-judgemental, culturally appropriate home.

Key Responsibilities:

- Provide **24/7 supervision and care** within a residential home environment.
- Build **safe, trusting relationships** with youth who have experienced trauma and exploitation.
- Support youth in developing **life skills, emotional regulation, and healthy coping strategies**.
- Implement **individual care plans, safety plans, and behavioural support strategies**.
- Maintain a **safe environment and monitor high-risk behaviours**, including potential exploitation risks.
- Respond calmly and effectively to **crisis situations or escalations**.
- Accompany youth to **appointments, school, and community activities**.
- Complete **accurate documentation and shift reports**.
- Work collaboratively with **CFS workers, clinicians, and program staff**.
- Follow all **agency policies, safety protocols, and confidentiality requirements**.

Qualifications:

- Experience working with **high-risk youth, trauma, exploitation, or the child welfare system** preferred.
- Education in **Child and Youth Care, Social Work, Psychology, or a related field** is an asset.
- Strong understanding of **trauma-informed and harm-reduction approaches**.
- Ability to maintain **firm boundaries while building supportive relationships**.
- Strong **crisis management and de-escalation skills**.
- Ability to work **independently and as part of a team**.
